Who is eligible to join?

- Non-profit international associations with rotating meetings are eligible to apply to join the ICCA Association Community
- At least one meeting must rotate across three countries, attract a minimum of 50 participants and be held on a regular basis
- The main contact person should be a Board member or Senior Director within the Management Team in charge of association meetings
- The Association Profile form should be signed by a Board member or Senior Director of the association

How can associations join the community?

- Complete the Association profile form on the ICCA website: www.associations.iccaworld.org
- Send your completed profile form to ICCA Head office to the attention of Director of Association Relations, Ksenija Polla, CMP at Ksenija.p@iccaworld.org
- Your submission will be reviewed by the ICCA Board within 14 working days
- After a positive acceptance of your submission and the payment of the administration fee you will officially become part of the community

What are the costs?

There is an annual administration fee of 250 Euros (excl. VAT) which will be invoiced in January of each year
